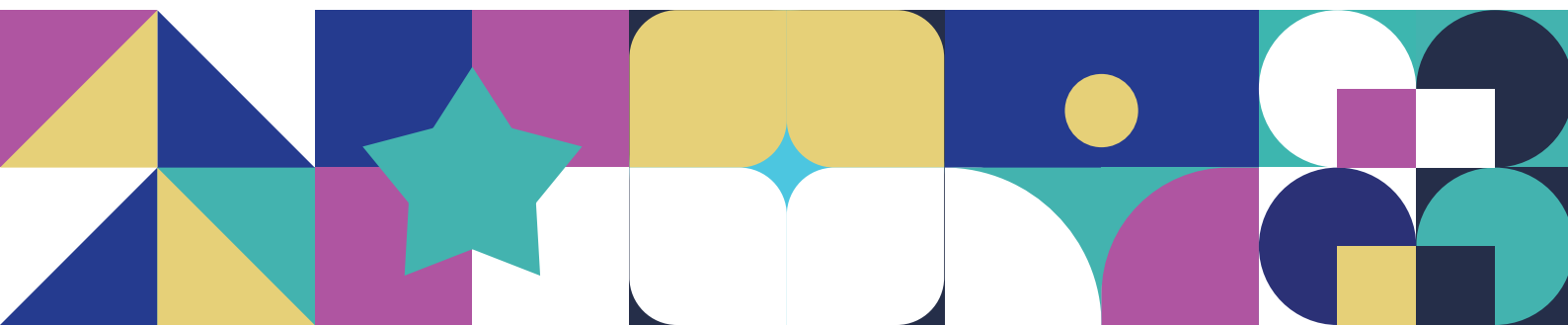

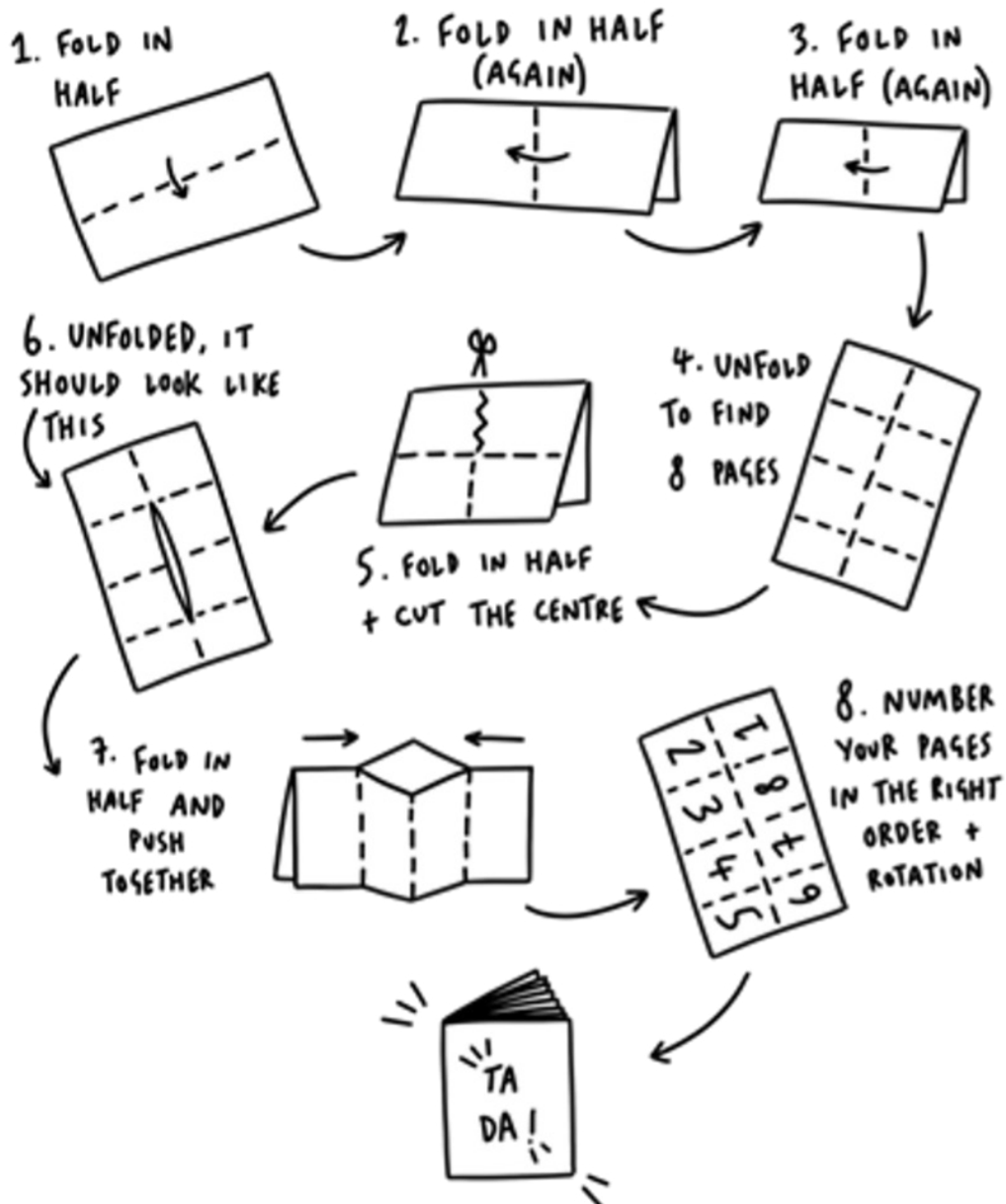


# All ages:

Follow these instructions and start writing, what will your zine be about?

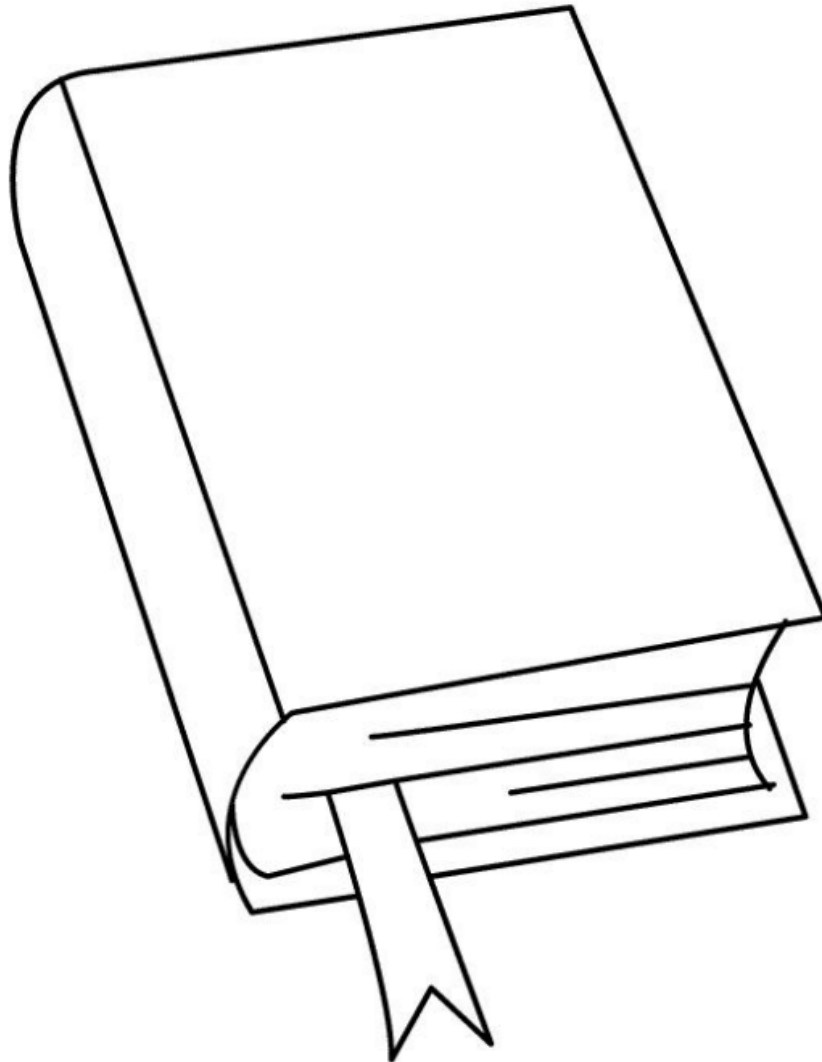

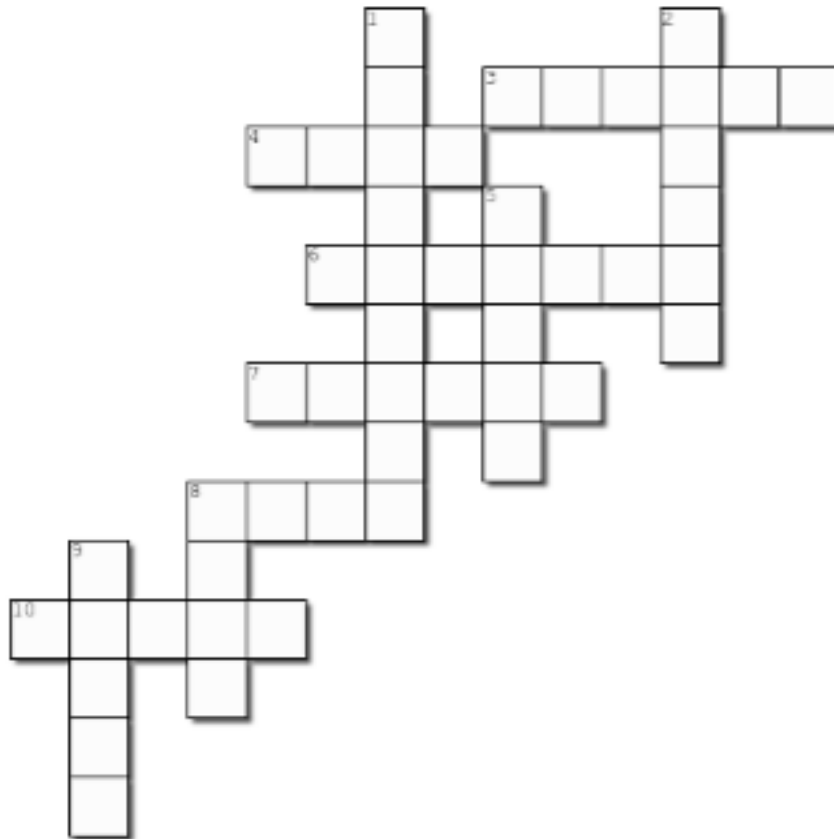

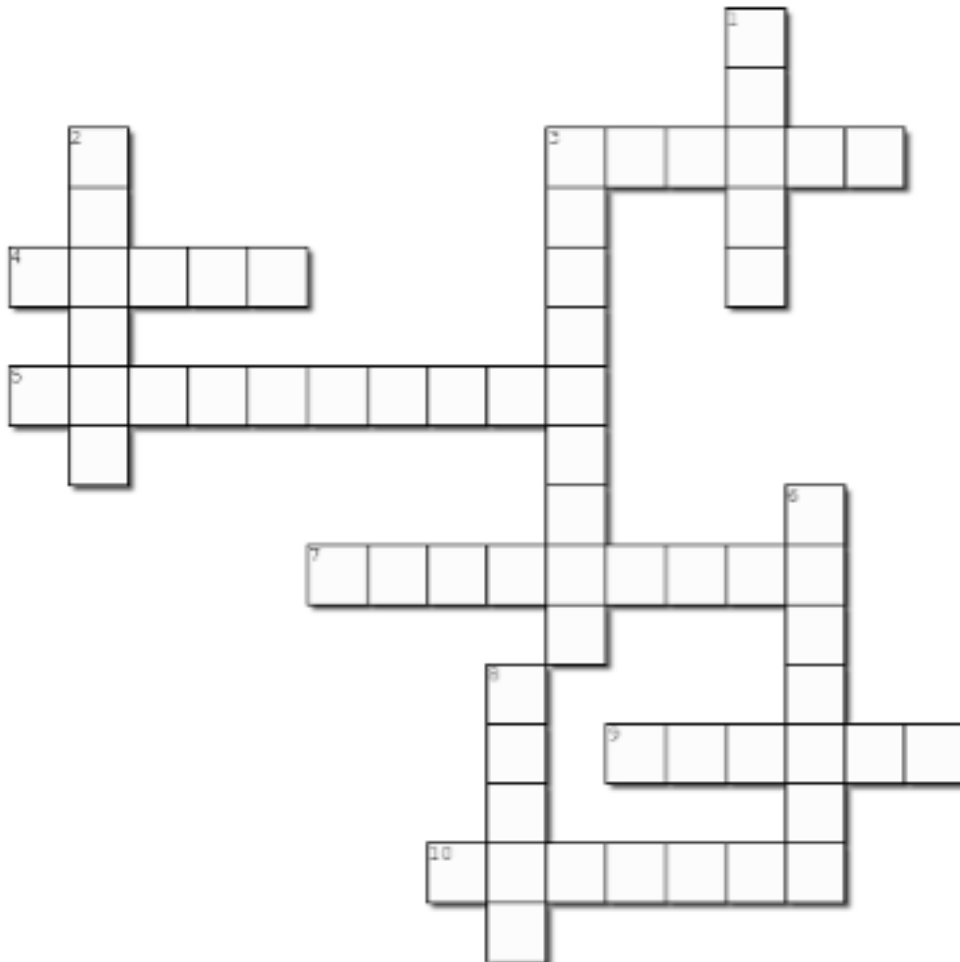
